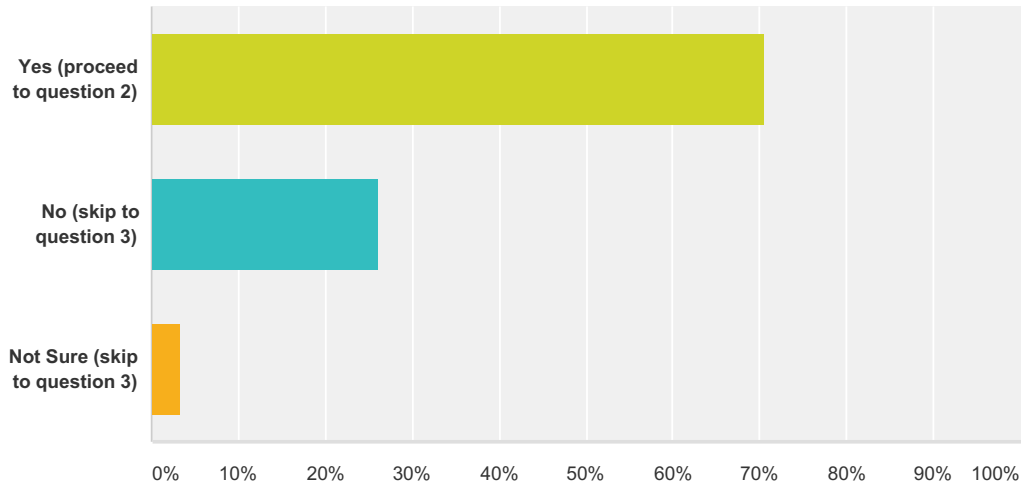


### Q1 Have you had contact with one or more Pleasant Ridge elected officials (Mayor and/or City Commissioners) in the past year?

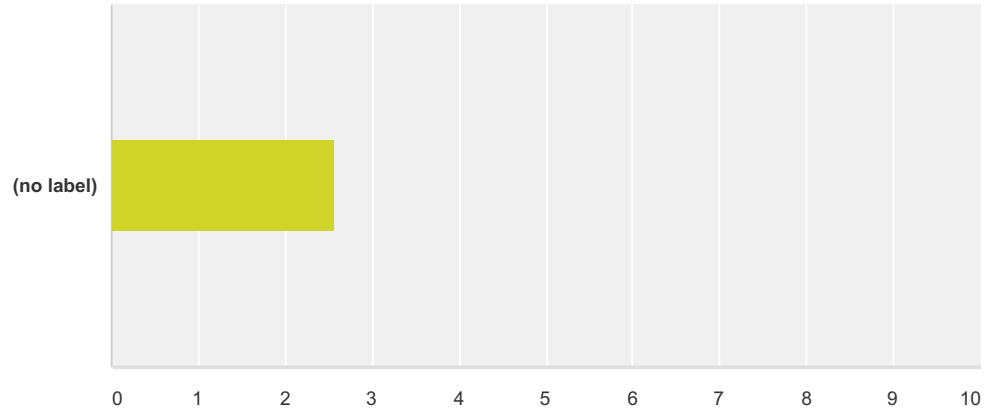

**Q2 IF you answered YES to question 1, how would you rate your contact with those elected officials?**

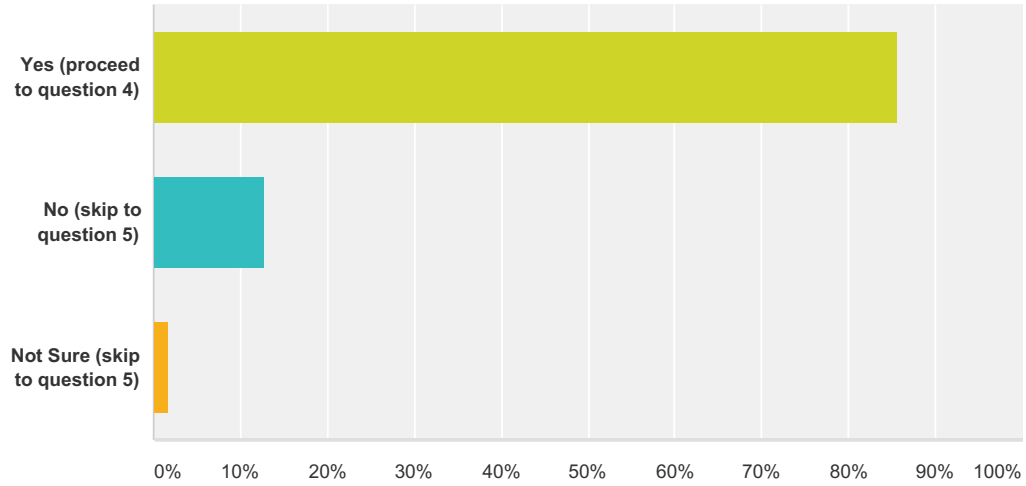

### Q3 Have you visited City Hall, or have you had direct contact with a Pleasant Ridge employee in the past year?

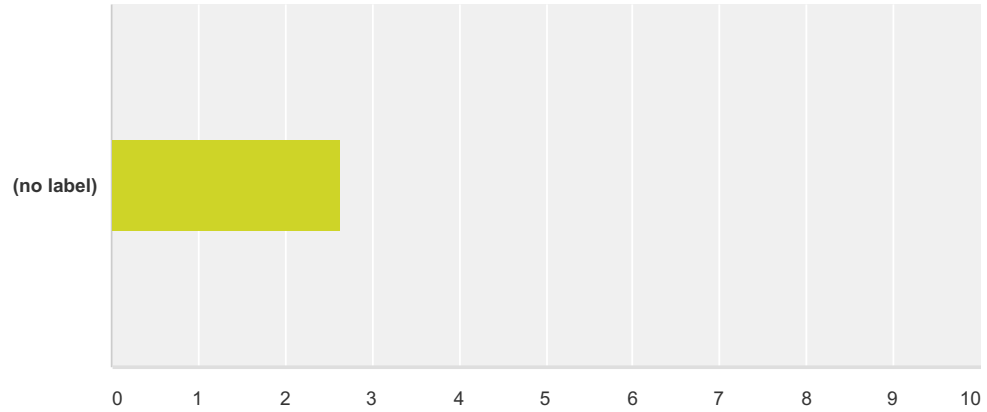

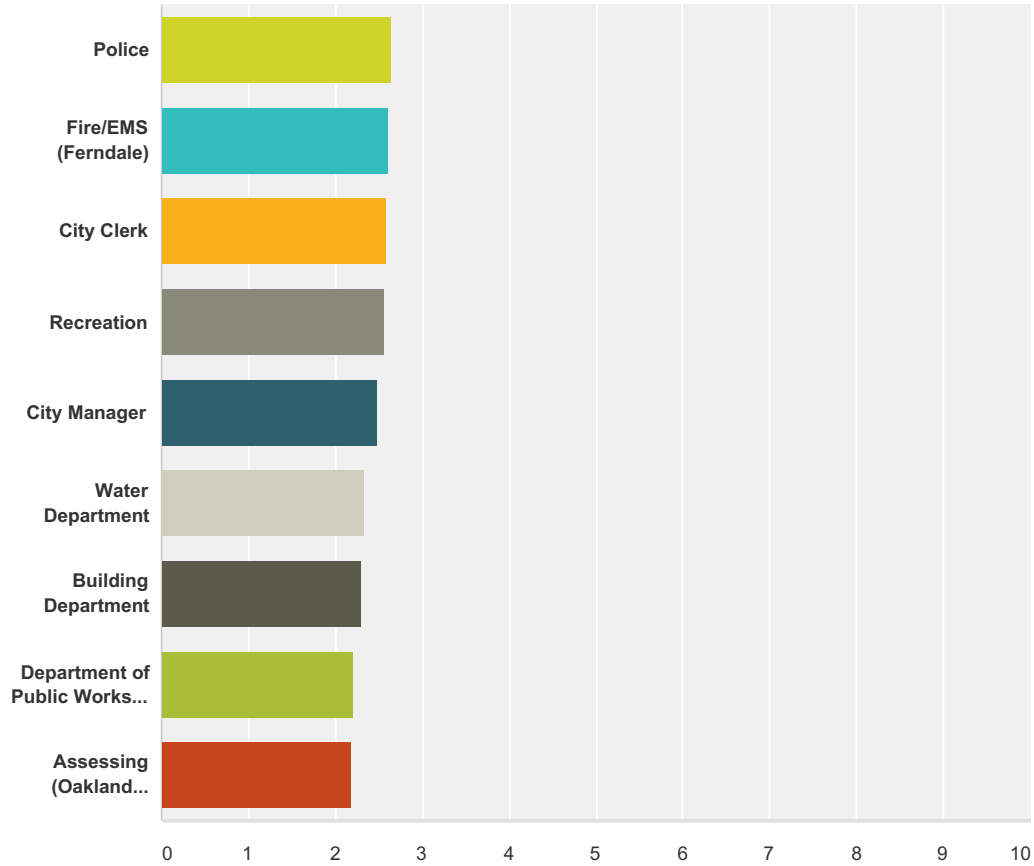

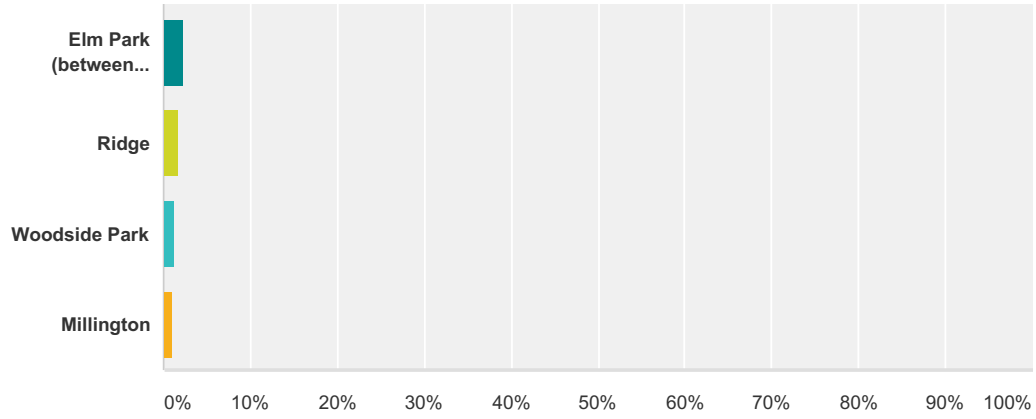

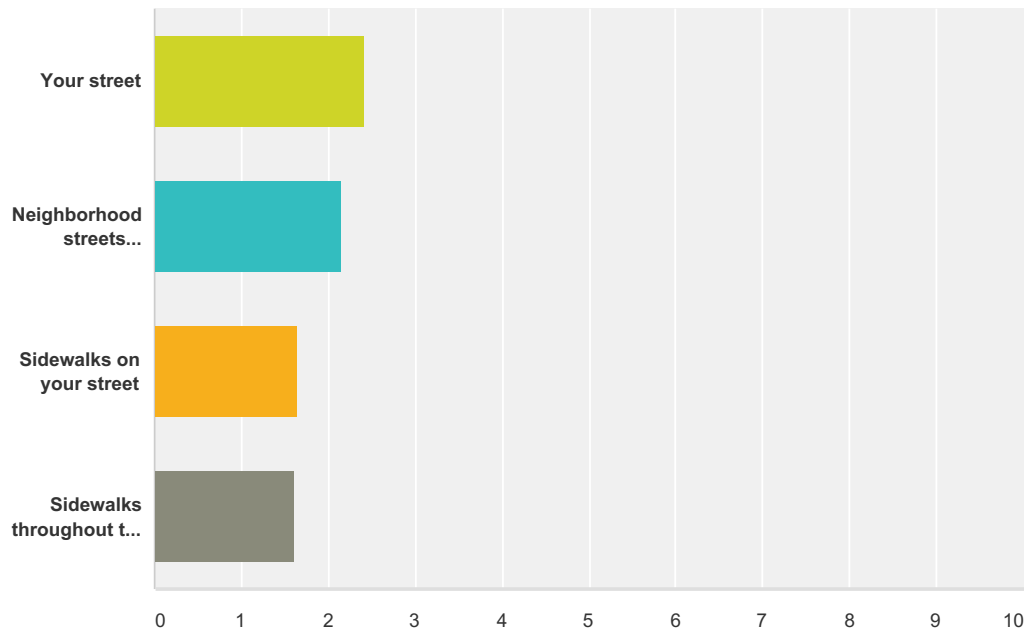

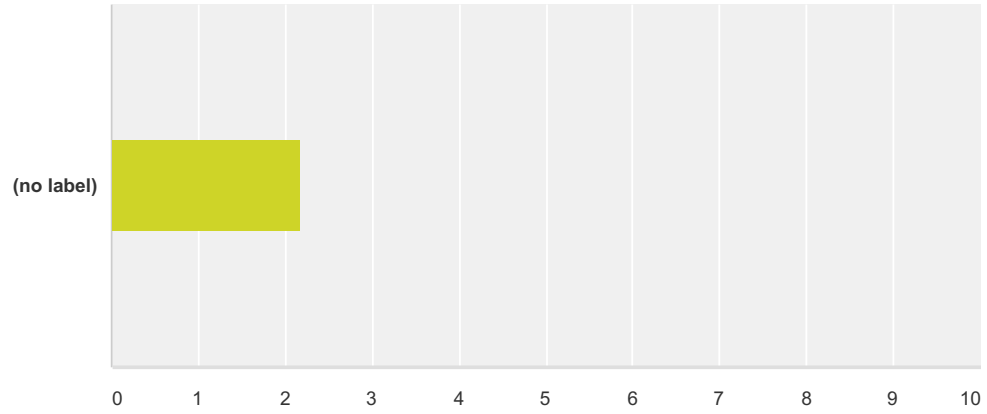

**Q8 How satisfied are you with routine maintenance on neighborhood streets in the City?**

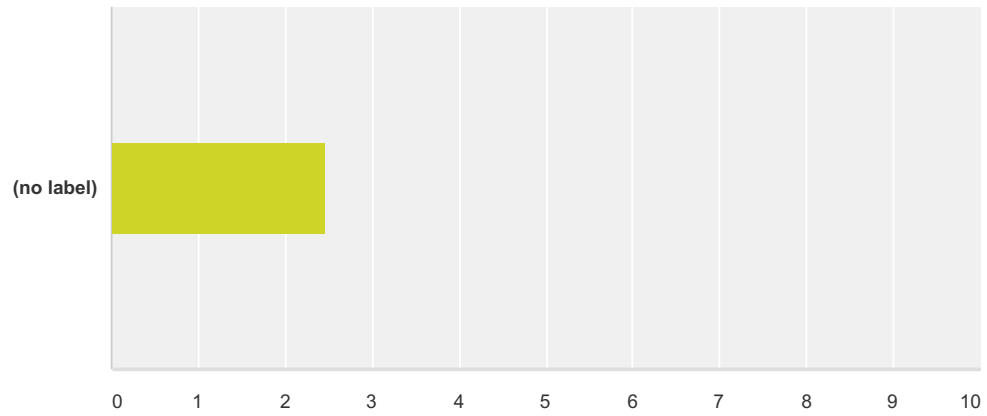

### Q9 How satisfied are you with snow and ice removal on neighborhood streets?

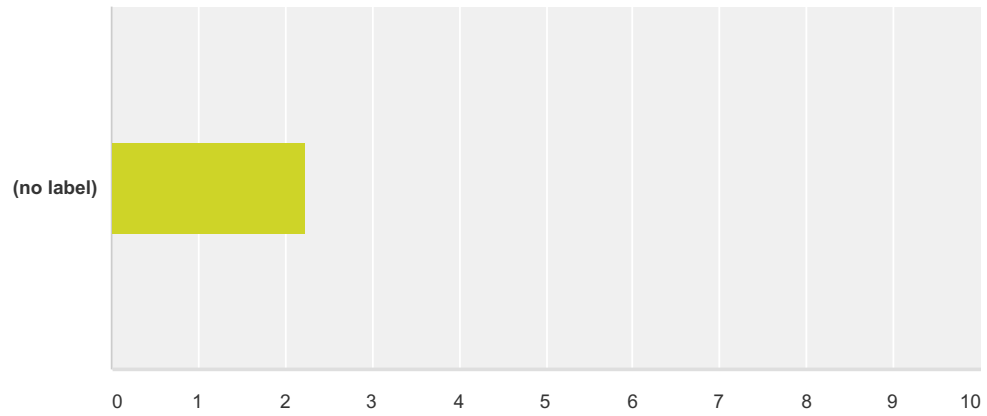

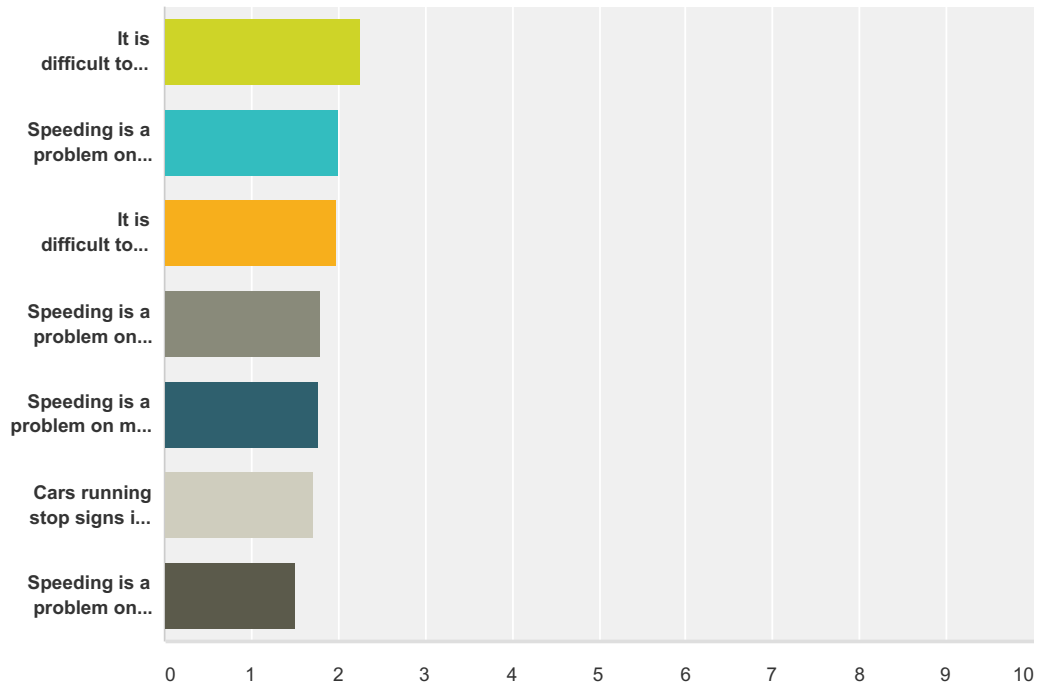

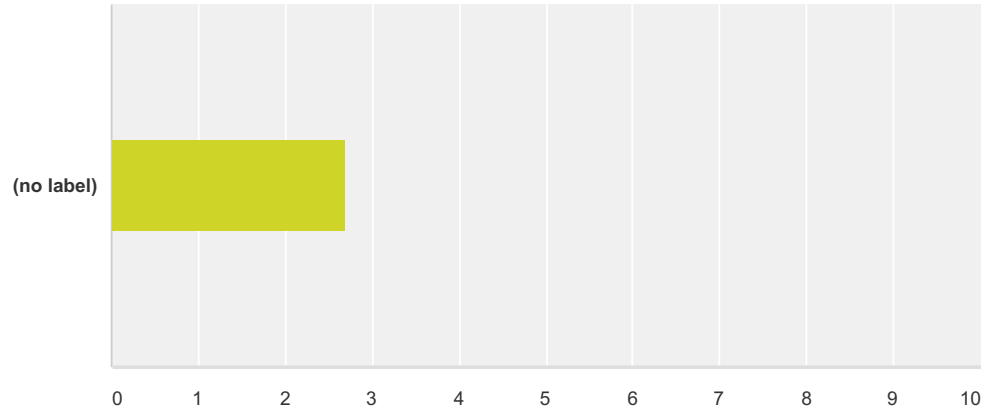

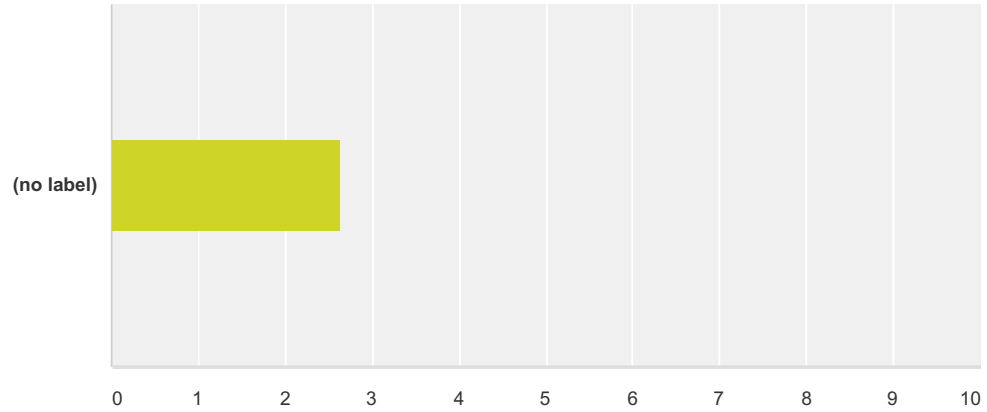

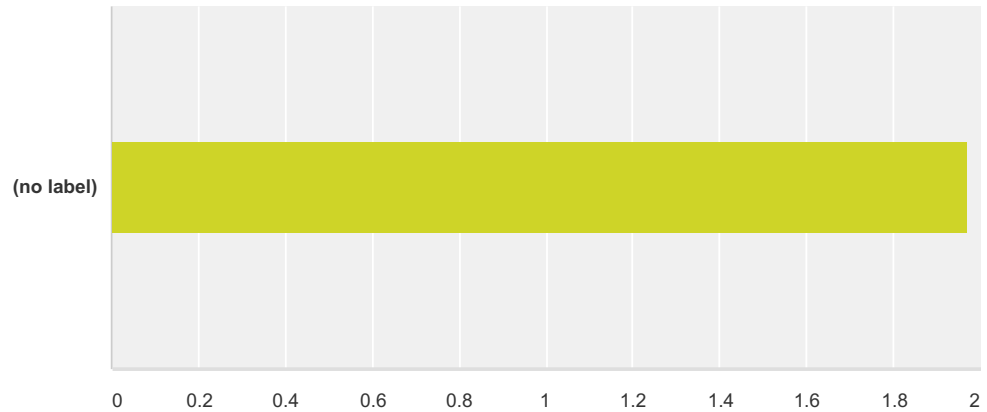

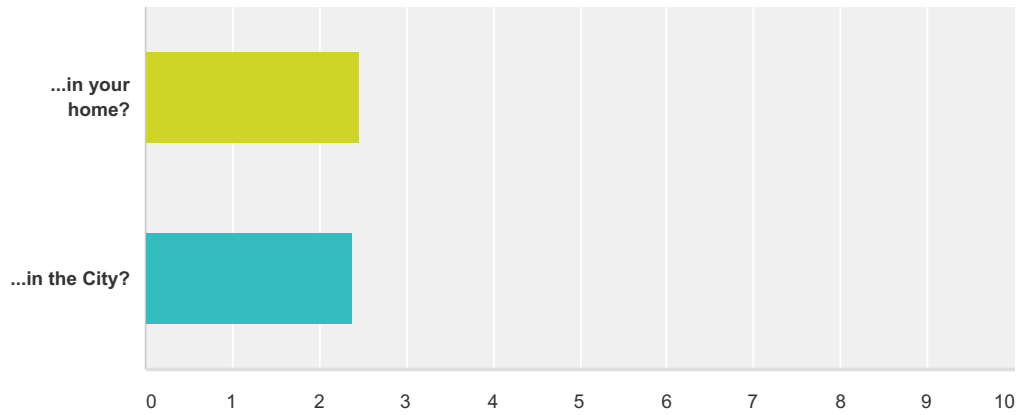

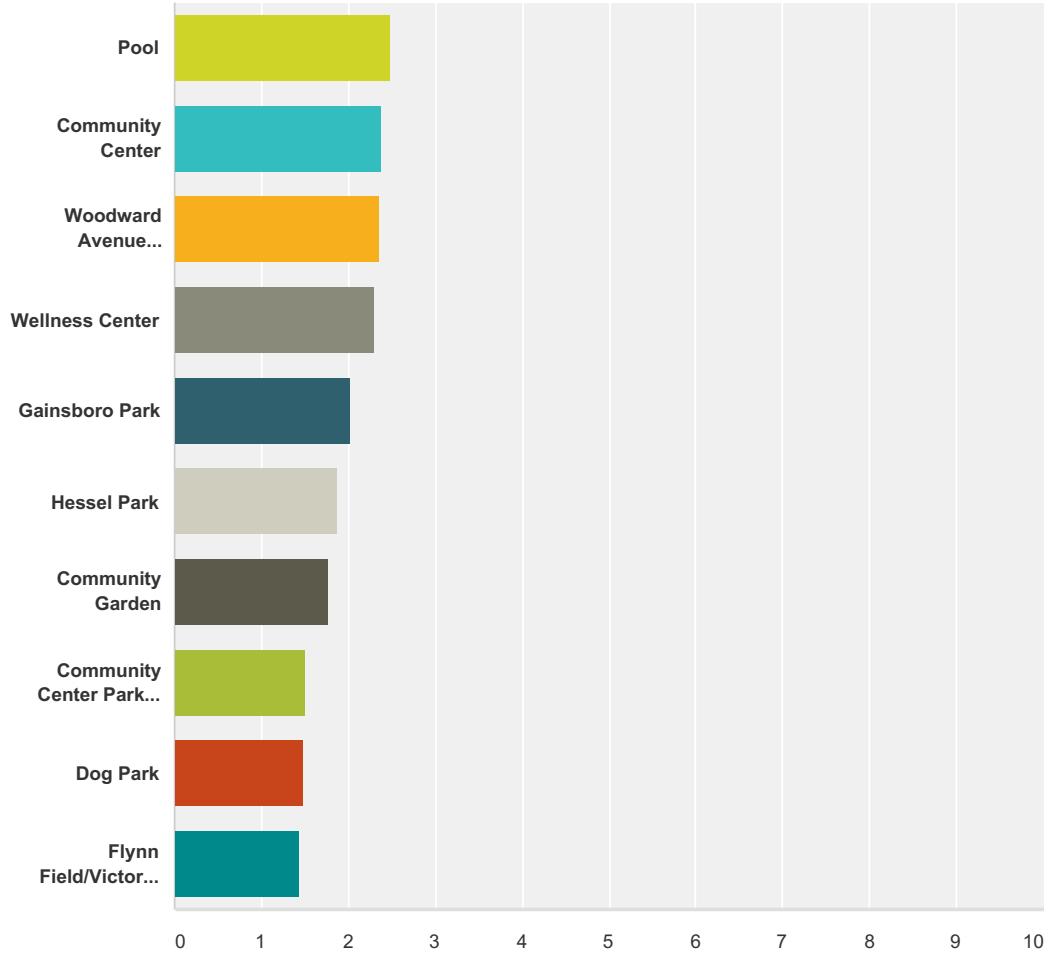

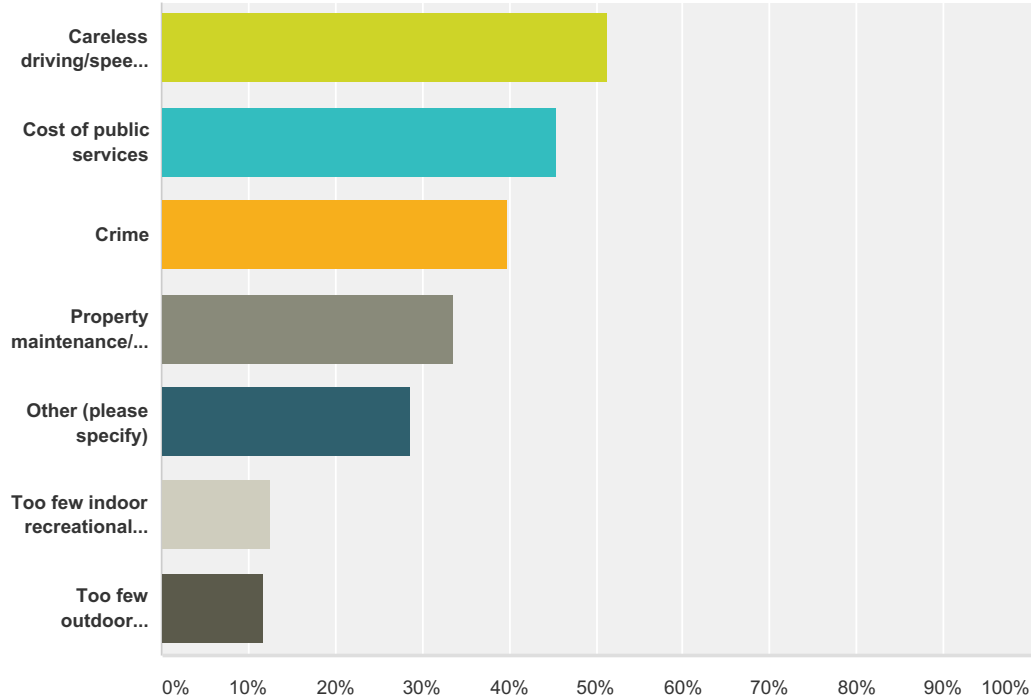

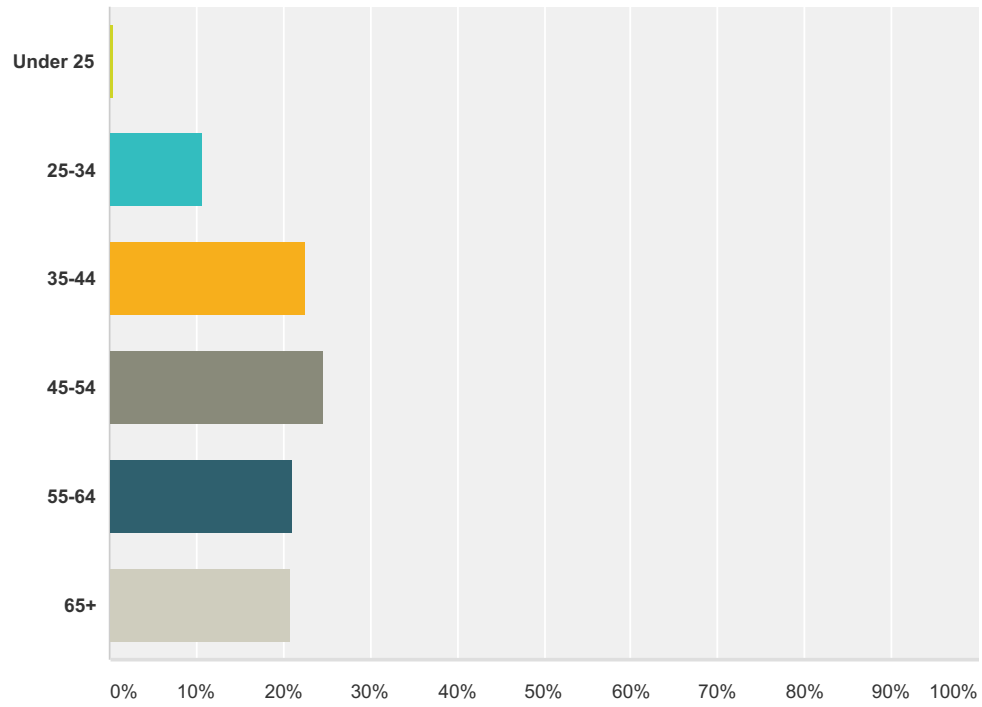

### Q25 Please indicate your age

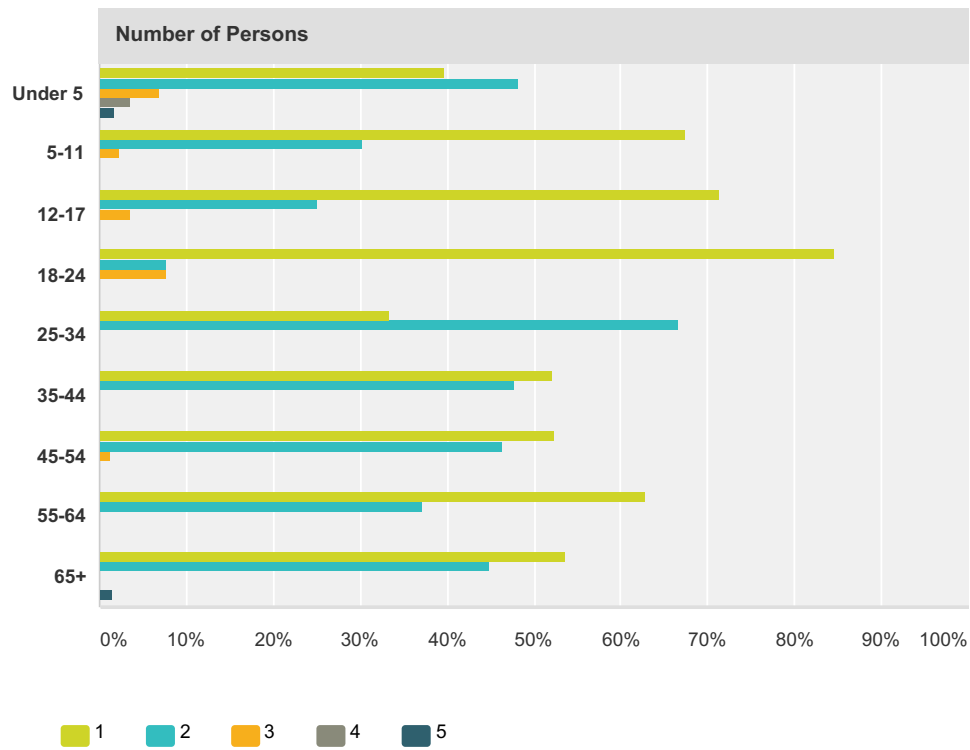

### Q26 Please indicate how many persons in your household are in each age group.

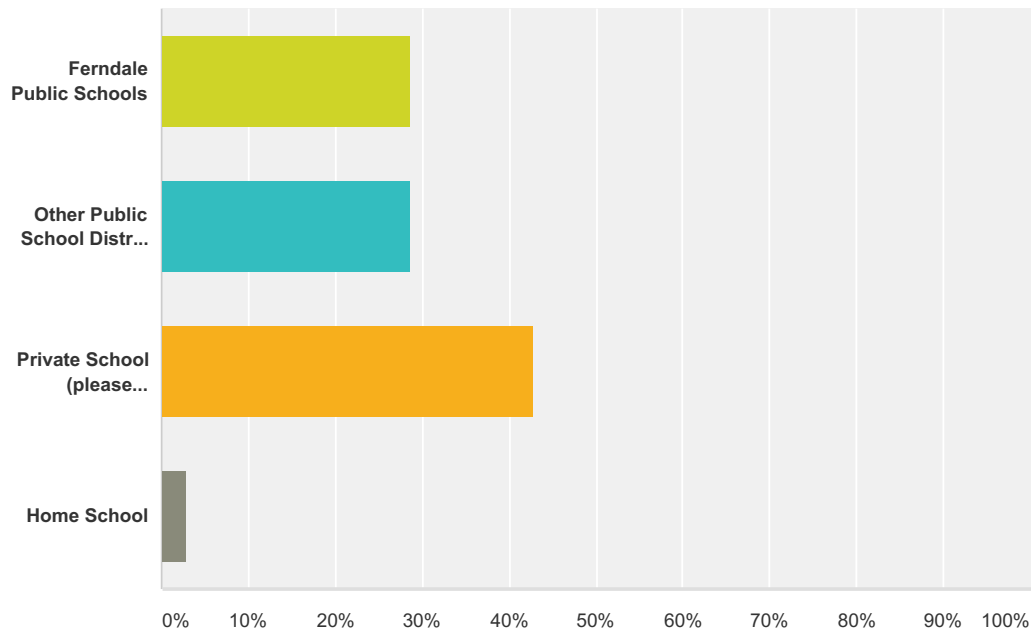

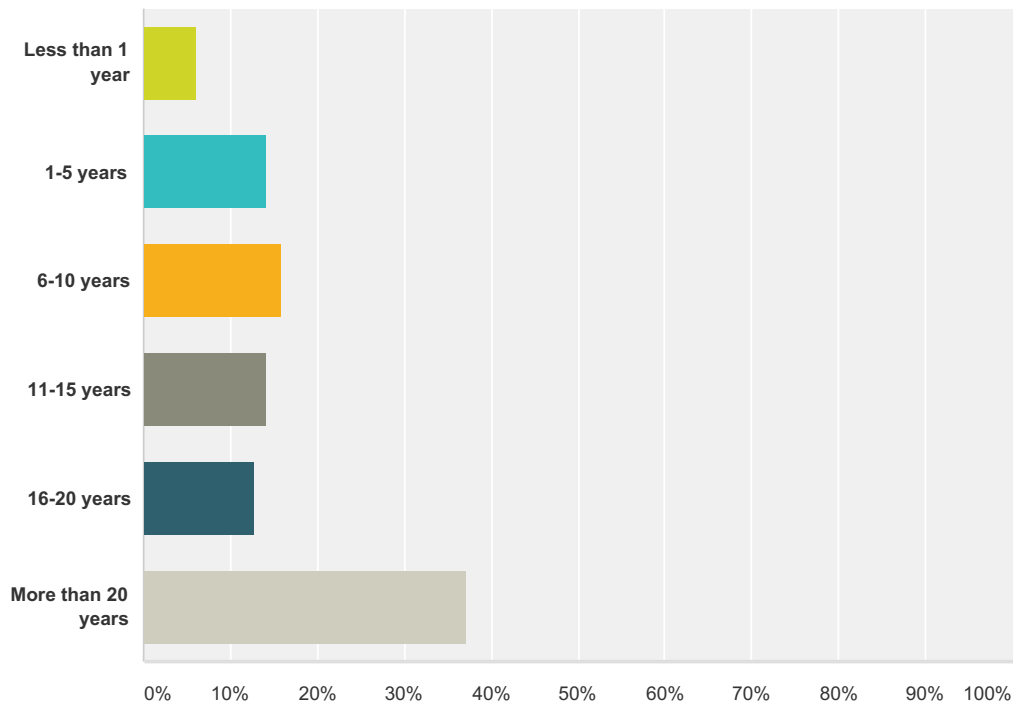

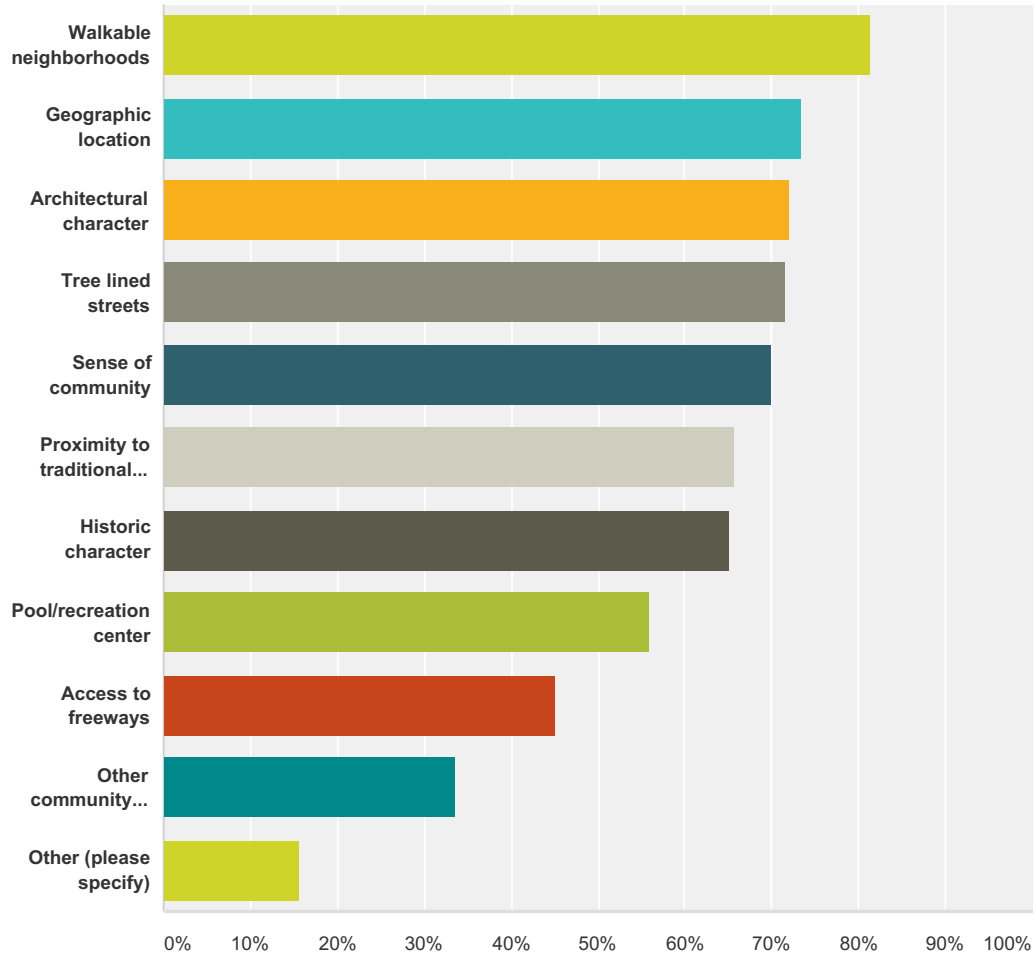

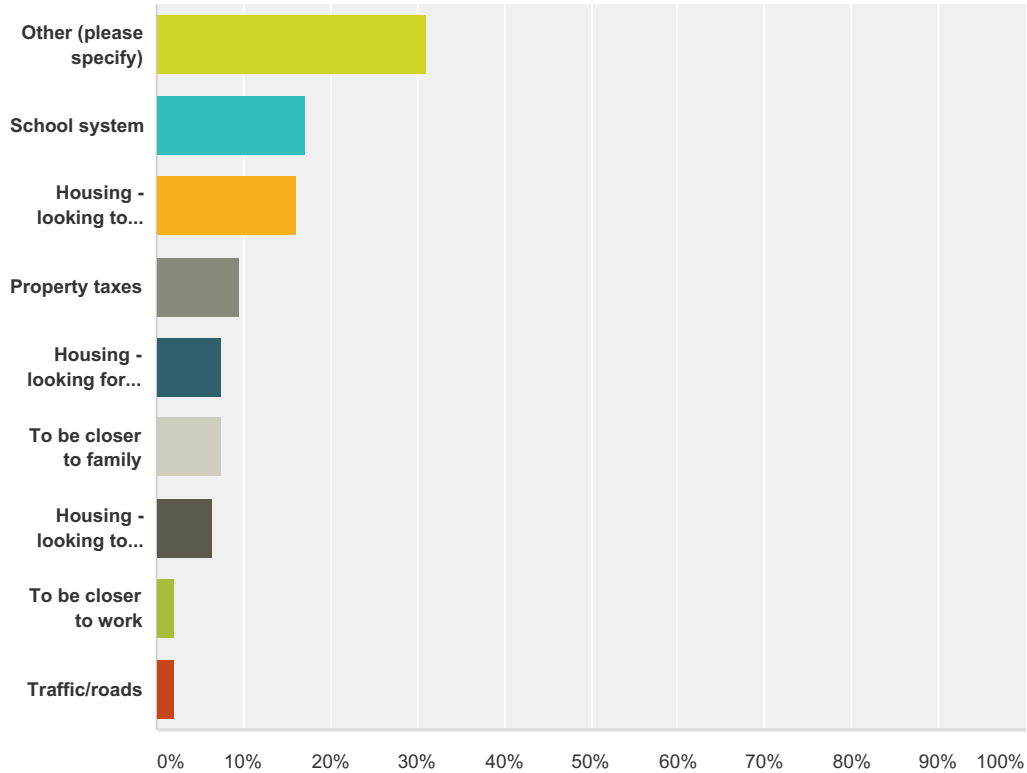
