To the Qualified Electors of the City of Pleasant Ridge, County of Oakland:

Notice is hereby given that the last day to register for the November 7, 2017, General Election will be **Tuesday, October 10, 2017.**

If you are not currently registered to vote or need to register at a new address, you may do so at the following locations and times:

In Person:

- City of Pleasant Ridge Clerk's offices 23925 Woodward Avenue, Pleasant Ridge, MI 48069, Monday-Thursday, 8:00am-5:00pm.
- County Elections Division, 1200 N. Telegraph Rd., Pontiac, MI 48341, Monday – Friday, 8:00am – 4:30pm.
- Secretary of State Branch Offices.
- At specified agencies for clients receiving services through Family Independence Agency, the Department of Community Health, Michigan Jobs Commission and some offices of the Commission for the Blind.
- At military recruitment offices for persons who are enlisting.

By Mail:

- Voter Registration Application - Mail to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline.

Note: Persons registering by mail are required to vote in person unless they have previously voted in person in the state or are at least 60 years of age or are handicapped.

The election will be conducted all voting precincts of Pleasant Ridge for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

CITY COMMISSIONER – 2 SEATS

AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ON THE FOLLOWING PROPOSAL(S):

Proposal 2017 – 1 - Police Pension Stabilization Millage Proposal

Shall the City of Pleasant Ridge be authorized to levy up to an additional 1.40 mills (\$1.40 per thousand dollars of taxable value), for the purposes of funding currently underfunded police pensions. The millage shall be authorized for a period of 15 years with the first levy in July 2018.

provided that the City shall not be authorized to increase such levy by more than 0.35 mills in 2018, or by more than an additional 0.35 mills each year thereafter, up to the maximum millage herein authorized. The initial 0.35 mill increase would raise the sum of approximately \$50,750 in 2018.
