

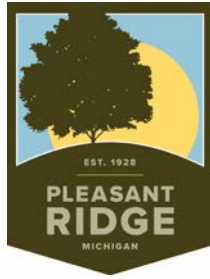

b: **Community Garden:** No garden in 2016. Further plans will be made once there is progress about the new location.

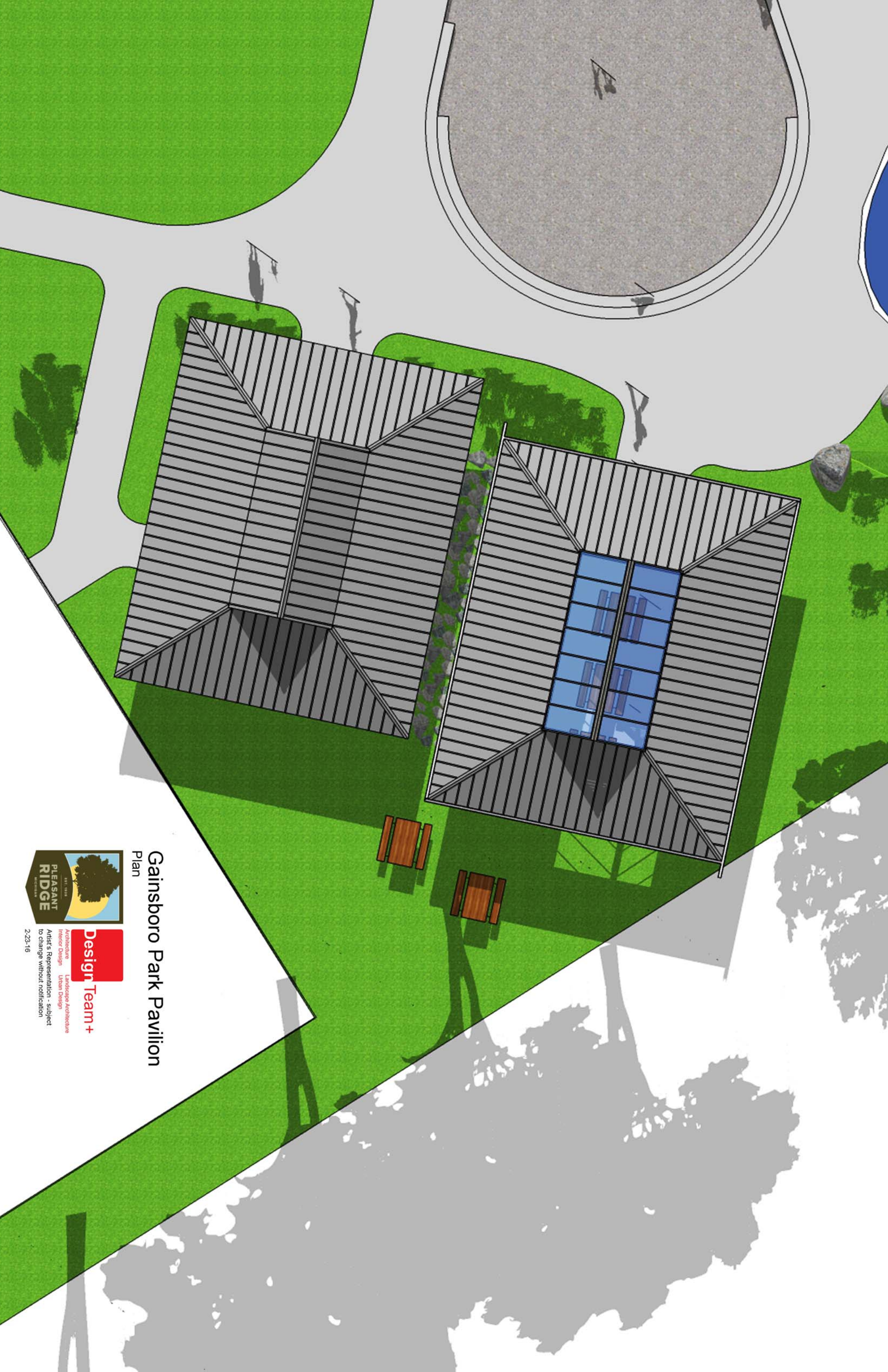
- c: **Health, Wellness and Play:** There will need to be a new schedule for summer events usually held in Gainsboro Park.

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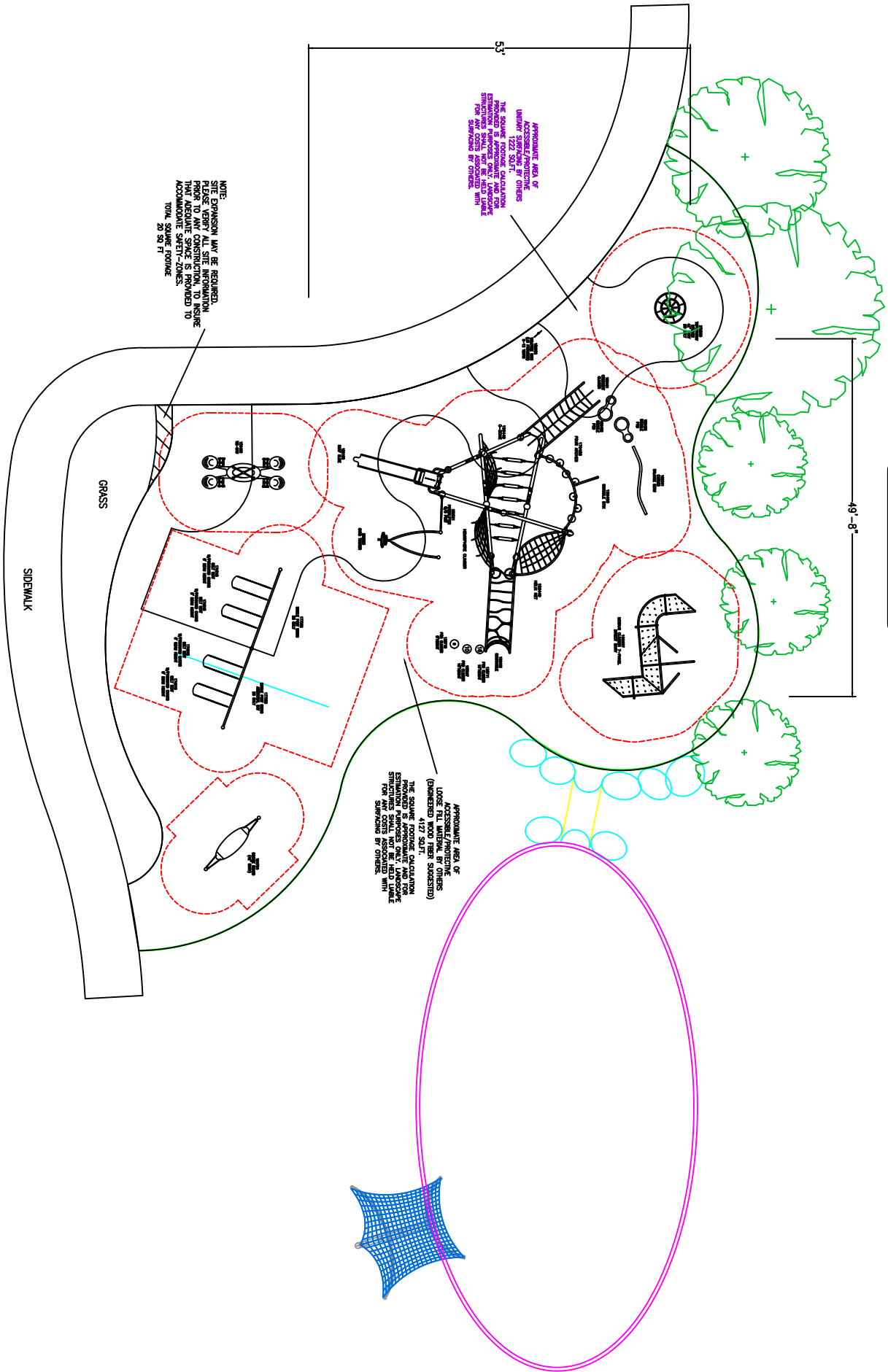

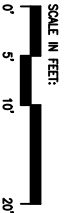
