Re:	5-12 year old Gainsboro play structure

After much research, park visits & public involvement the sub-committee has decided on a recommendation for a new 5-12 play structure for Gainsboro. The recommendation is for the design we have showed the group at previous meetings with a couple possible changes (size limitations). The recommendation is highlighted below and with the attached pictures.

- Landscape Structures EVOS System
- Component pieces that include
 - o 7 Panel Mobius Climber
 - Proposed Global Motion (size) or Topsy Turny
 - Boogie Board
 - o We-Saw
 - o Swings

The recommended surface will be a hybrid of PIP (poured in place) surface and engineered wood fiber. The sub-committee feels this will give the play area maximum usage for all populations & special needs.

Therefore, the recommendation is to approve the EVOS design and corresponding components, with the Global Motion & Topsy Turny to be interchangeable based on space limitations. The surface will be a hybrid of PIP & engineered wood fiber.
