The City of Pleasant Ridge will conduct a video conference Town Hall meeting to discuss replacement of the City's water infrastructure.

New rules adopted by the State of Michigan require the City to remove and replace lead service lines (the pipes that run from the water main to the meter inside your house) at public cost. Please refer to the attached one-page overview of the project that was included in the January edition of the Ridger.

Most of the City's water mains are also approaching

100 years old and are due for replacement. We will review our plan for replacing the City's entire water

system infrastructure over the next 30 years, including options for how to pay for these improvements. The cost to complete these improvements will require water rate and/or property tax increases, as will be discussed at the Town Hall meeting. The City Commission is seeking your input on how you would prefer these costs to be handled.

The meeting will be held via Zoom video conference. It will also be broadcast live on the City's YouTube channel at www.youtube.com/user/PleasantRidgeCity and on public access television stations. The meeting will be recorded and made available for viewing on the City website and YouTube channel after the meeting.






PR POOLSign Up to Swim

Please check the registration page for the pool schedule. New this season! Residents wishing to swim at the Pleasant Ridge Pool must sign up for a time slot in advance. Every person coming to the pool must sign up for a time slot. Here's how:

- 1 Visit https://pleasantridge.activityreg.com/
- 2 Click on "Pool Time Slots"
- Click on the date and time slot you would like to sign up for
- 4 Click on "Sign in" or "Create a New Account"
- Select Member and accept the waiver. Then click "Add to Cart." EVERY person coming to the pool MUST sign up for a time slot!
- 6 Click on "Check Out"
- 7 Click on "Pay"

2021 Pleasant Ridge Pool Rules

- Must present a current Picture ID to update your 2021 Pool Pass (see back page on how to get your 2021 pool pass)
- · All household members must have a pass & check-in for each visit.
 - · All swimmers must wear a lined swimsuit.
 - No smoking of ANY kind at the pool. Must be 30 ft from the building.
- No glass containers or alcoholic beverages allowed at the pool.
 - Arm "floaties" not allowed. All floatation devices must be U.S. Coast Guard-approved.
 - No flips or backward dives off the diving board.
 - · No snorkels or aquatic face masks.

Pleasant Ridge "Leaders in Training" Program 2021

The LIT Program allows for our teen population to develop strong leadership skills and develop taking initiative. LIT's spend the summer making new friends, gaining work experience and having fun. LIT's will receive training and "on the job" feedback, support and evaluation.

Summer LIT opportunities include:

Current 7th Grade (2020-21 school year) & Up: Summer Camp, Special Events, Outdoor Pool and Front Desk.

There is a nominal fee for the LIT Program to help offset some of the costs incurred with the program. The fee covers LIT training, t-shirts, and supervision. \$25 for the summer.

LIT applications are available at the Front Desk April 12 and must be turned in by May 10.

Full payment must accompany the application as well as the availability calendar attached to the packet. Late applications will not be accepted. Every attempt is made to accommodate as many applicants as possible, but spaces are limited. Placements are based on age, previous experience and availability. This program is only open to PR residents, limited to 25 spots.

Summer Camp 2021 Day Camp Program

Camp numbers will be limited to 50 spots per week Due to Summer Day Camp Guidelines and Regulations,

we have had to make some modifications to the program. We will be offering six one-week sessions and a partial week session the week of July 4. Camp numbers will be limited based on the capacity set by the State. Camp fees* will be \$55 per camper (\$27.50 for Week 3), plus the additional cost of the optional field trip (field trip numbers will be limited based on transportation and venue numbers). *No refunds will be issued for any programs or activities unless canceled by the Recreation Department.



The PR Wellness Center is open, and we ask that patrons continue to follow these rules:
